Single Fire Sprinkler Stops Apartment Fire in High-Rise Building

A single fire sprinkler extinguished a fire caused by a candle that was left unattended in a tenant's apartment.

Instead of headline news about a major tragedy, the fire sprinkler limited damage to just \$2,000 and did not displace the tenants for even a single day.
