Professional Membership

The Professional category of membership was created for architects, engineers, and other professionals. It is intended for people who are self-employed or members of small firms. If you supply products or services, such as computer programs or technical services, directly to fire sprinkler contractors and others in the fire sprinkler industry, you are eligible for NFSA's "SAM" (Supplier and Manufacturer) membership category.

Unlike other NFSA membership categories, Professional memberships are for *individuals*. Only one copy of member publications will be sent per membership. Larger firms with branch offices or more than five employees joining as professionals may find it to their advantage to enroll the company as a "SAM" member. Employees of fire sprinkler contracting companies are not eligible for Professional membership.

Publications

Professional membership in the NFSA will keep you fully informed in all areas of fire sprinkler protection through NFSA's four membership publications.

Sprinkler Quarterly
