CONGRATULATIONS CHIEF CURT KRAMER, FIRE MARSHAL TREVOR HERRMANN, CAPTAIN BILL ROBINSON AND THE HAMPSHIRE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT BOARD!

In a recent effort to increase fire safety and protect Hampshire residents and visitors, the Hampshire Village Board has worked closely with Chief Curt Kramer and Fire Marshal Trevor Herrmann of the Hampshire Fire Protection District to pass a fire sprinkler ordinance that follows the 2006 International Building Code and 2006 International Fire Code with progressive amendments. The ordinance requires fire sprinkler protection in all new commercial occupancies. Existing commercial structures will require a fire sprinkler system if renovations meet or exceed 50% of their total square footage. Any other renovations which fall below the 50% mark will require the installation of a fire alarm system. All new multi-family occupancies, including townhomes and those larger than a duplex, will also require fire sprinkler protection.

As a result, the Village of Hampshire will become a truly fire safe community protecting those people who live, work and visit. The ordinance also helps safeguard the firefighters who respond to emergency incidents.
